Dear Steering Committee Member:

We are writing to let you know more about our plans for the upcoming peer review and Steering Committee meeting along with your potential involvement in these meetings. As we notified you on January 26 by email, our next activities will take place over two days and will involve the outside peer reviewers we proffered last fall in our October 18 letter to you. These two days will be as follows:

Day One – Team Work Session: February 27, 2007 (8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Tentative)

This day will be a work session between the Project Team and the peer reviewers. It will last all day beginning around 8:00 or 9:00 a.m. and lasting until approximately 5:00 or 6:00 p.m. We will provide the peer reviewers with background on the project and technical information. We will answer questions and provide an overview of our activities to date. This Day One Team Work Session will not be a formal Steering Committee meeting, however it will be open for you and the public to observe the work and discussions. There will be an opportunity for Steering Committee members who wish to provide any comments regarding the project to the peer reviewers. There will also be an opportunity for public comment as well.

While this day is not an official Steering Committee meeting, we invite each of you to spend as much time as you can afford to observe this process. We also invite any of you who wish to provide verbal comments to the peer reviewers to be present between the hours of 2:00 and 3:00 p.m. for that purpose.

Day Two – Steering Committee Meeting: February 28, 2008 (9:00 am – 1:30 pm Tentative)

Day Two will be Steering Committee Meeting No. 8. We are still finalizing the Day Two schedule however it appears this meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. and will last until approximately 1:00 or 1:30 p.m. with lunch toward the end of the meeting. During this meeting, there will be a brief overview of the activities that have been ongoing since our last Steering Committee meeting and a brief review of some of the information from Day One. After that, we will have a report to the Steering Committee and Project Team from the peer reviewers. There will also be time for interaction between the Steering Committee and the peer reviewers. As with all Steering Committee meetings, there will be time for public comment during the meeting.
